...discrimination against Jews

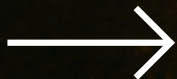
... prejudices aimed at the Jewish community and Jewish communal spaces

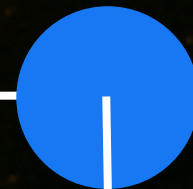
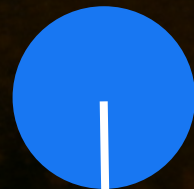

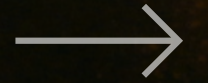

This idea claims that Jews used the blood of Christian boys for religious rituals. (MYTH) Blood libel accusations often led to violent riots launched against Jews and frequently encouraged by government authorities.

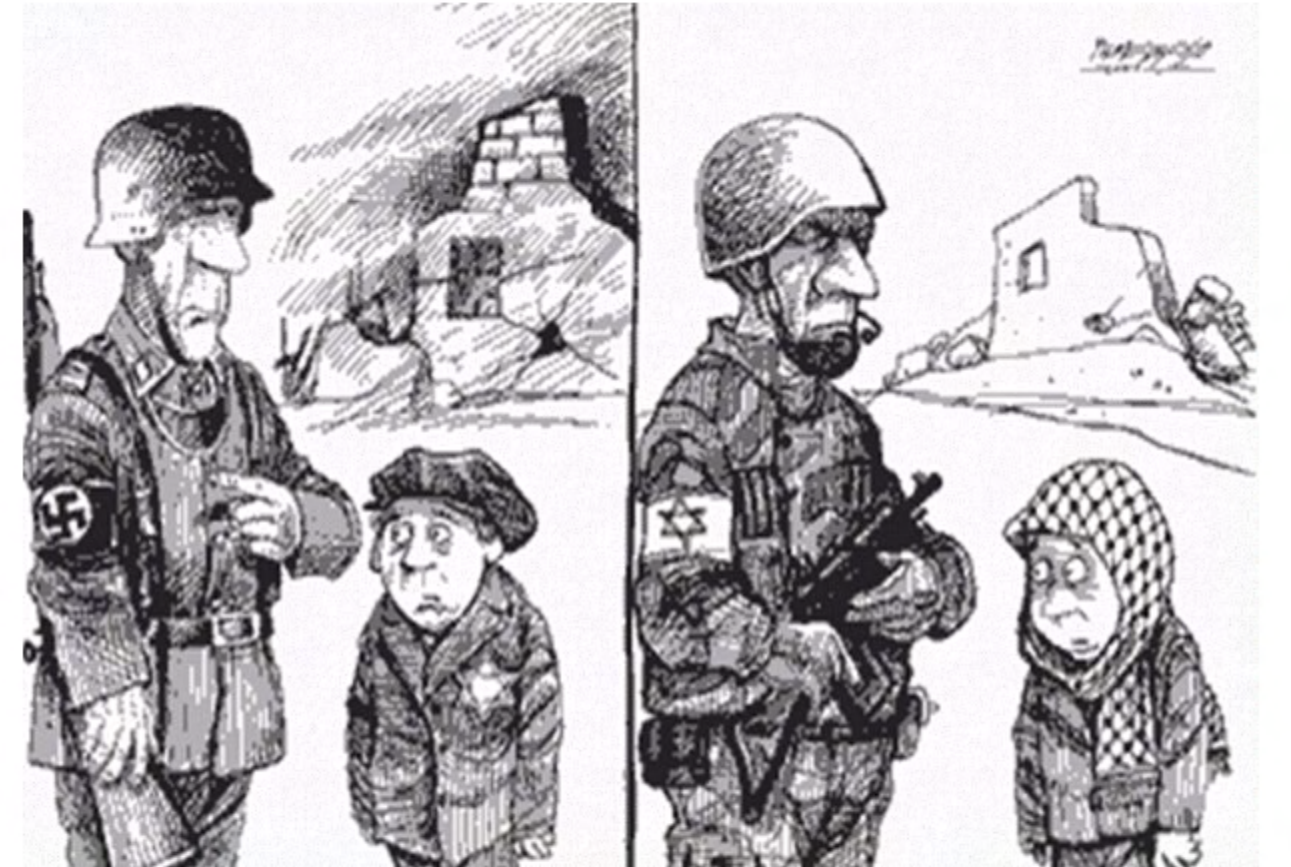
Demonization: When Israel is made to seem evil; actions are blown out of proportion, blamed 100%, compared to Nazis
